AS A CITY OF PATRIOTISM

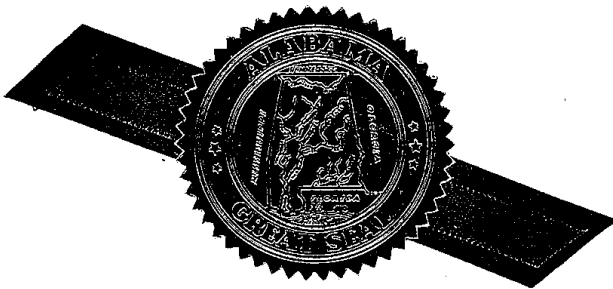
